

Official Contest Rules

Prodigy Education Inc. o/a Prodigy Game (“Prodigy” or “Company”)

We’re celebrating Back to School with the Clear the List Giveaway (the “Contest”) sponsored by Prodigy. To be eligible for entry, participants must either:

(a) sign up for a new Prodigy Teacher Account, attach their classroom at a verified school, and add students to their classroom between July 20 and September 11, 2026, or

(b) sign in to their existing Prodigy Teacher Account, create a new classroom with a school attached, and add students to this classroom during the same period.

Note: Teachers whose classrooms and student rosters are automatically set up via Clever District Sync must still log in to their accounts to receive their entry.

The Contest runs from 12:00 AM UTC on July 20, 2026, to 11:59 PM UTC on September 11, 2026.

Each week during the Contest Period, twenty-five (25) winners will be selected from entries received the previous week (Monday through Friday) to receive a \$250 USD/CAD Amazon e-Gift Card. A total of two hundred (200) winners will be selected over the 8-week Contest Period.

Gift cards are intended to support classroom-related purchases tied to #ClearTheList Amazon wishlists.

1. HOW TO ENTER

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.
PURCHASE DOES NOT INCREASE ODDS OF WINNING.

To enter the Contest, you must be 18 years of age or older, and a teacher in North America (excluding Quebec). Applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations apply. Void where prohibited by law. By submitting an entry to the Contest, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to be bound by these Contest Rules and the decisions of the Company, and that you satisfy all eligibility requirements.

How to enter:

- New Prodigy users are automatically entered into the Contest with one (1) entry by signing up for a Prodigy Teacher Account with a school attached, and adding students to their classroom, between July 20 and September 11, 2026.

- Existing users with a school attached are automatically entered into the Contest with one (1) entry by creating their first qualifying classroom and adding students to it during the Contest Period.
- **Note:** Teachers whose classrooms and student rosters are automatically set up via Clever District Sync must log in to their accounts to receive their entry.

Bonus entries:

- Teachers can receive one (1) extra entry by having 5 or more students actively playing Prodigy. The students must be attached to the teacher's account and part of a class created after July 1, 2026.
- Teachers can receive one (1) extra entry by signing up for a back-to-school webinar hosted by Prodigy on or before September 11, 2026.

Each eligible participant may only win once throughout the duration of the contest. The maximum number of entries per participant is three (3): one (1) base entry and up to two (2) bonus entries.

2. ELIGIBILITY

Contest is open to elementary school teachers who are 18 years of age or older at the Contest opening date, and who are teachers with classes attached to a verified school in the 50 United States and the District of Columbia (each a "State"), or teachers with classes attached to a verified school recognized by ODEF in Canada (excluding Quebec), subject to all applicable federal, state, provincial and local laws and regulations.

A verified school is an identifiable school as determined by Prodigy in its sole discretion. Participants must have a valid verified school affiliation and be assigned to a school. A valid school email address may be required to confirm school affiliation and verified school. If a teacher deletes their created classroom during the Contest Period, they will no longer be eligible for the giveaway. Winners will be required to provide information about their verified school prior to receiving their prize.

Employees of Prodigy, as well as such employees' immediate family (father/mother, brother/sister, son/daughter) or persons living under the same roof are not eligible to enter this Contest.

This contest is void where prohibited by law.

3. CONTEST PERIOD

The Contest begins on July 20, 2026 at 12:00 AM UTC and ends on September 11, 2026 at 11:59 PM UTC (the “Contest Period”).

Draws for the week’s twenty-five (25) weekly winners will take place each week on Monday during the Contest Period for entries from the previous week. The final draw for the last week of the Contest will be on September 14, 2026.

Winners will be notified via their email associated with their Prodigy account within five business days following each draw.

4. PROCEDURE FOR AWARDING PRIZES

Each week during the Contest Period, twenty-five (25) winners will be randomly selected from all eligible entries received during the previous week (Monday through Sunday). Draws will take place each Monday and will determine the winners for the prior week's entries. Participants who have not yet won remain eligible for future draws. Once a participant wins, they are no longer eligible for future draws.

Winners will be contacted via the email associated with their Prodigy account within five business days following each draw. If a winner cannot be reached within five days, declines the prize, or fails to return the required verification, the prize will be forfeited, and an alternate winner may be selected.

Canadian winners will be required to correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question without assistance before being awarded their prize. The skill-testing question will be administered at the time of winner notification.

Weekly Draw and Notification Dates:

- Monday, July 27 (winners drawn from entries received July 20–26)
- Monday, August 3 (winners drawn from entries received July 27–August 2)
- Monday, August 10 (winners drawn from entries received August 3–9)
- Monday, August 17 (winners drawn from entries received August 10–17)
- Monday, August 24 (winners drawn from entries received August 17–23)
- Monday, August 31 (winners drawn from entries received August 24–30)
- Tuesday, September 8 (postponed from September 7 due to Labor Day; winners drawn from entries received August 31–September 7)
- Monday, September 14 (winners drawn from entries received September 7–11)

Note: Draws take place weekly on Mondays. Each draw selects winners from entries received during the prior week (Monday through Friday). Entries submitted on Saturdays or Sundays will be included in the following week's draw.

5. DESCRIPTION OF PRIZE(S)

- There are two hundred (200) prizes, each consisting of one (1) \$250 Amazon e-Gift Card for use for classroom-related purchases (Prizes will be provided in USD for U.S. participants and CAD for Canadian participants).
- The approximate retail value of each prize is \$250 USD/CAD and the total approximate retail value of all prizes is \$50,000 USD/CAD.

6. GENERAL RULES

6.1. Each winner shall sign a release declaring their eligibility as stipulated in Section 2 of these rules; agreeing that their name may be used for advertising purposes related to this Contest free of charge; and releasing the Company as well as its respective directors, officers and employees (the "Contest Parties") from all liability for any damage or loss arising from participation in this Contest or from the awarding, acceptance or use of the prize.

6.2. The prize shall be accepted as is and may not be exchanged or refunded for an amount of money, sold or transferred. No substitutions will be allowed. Any unused portion of a prize will be forfeited.

6.3. If the prize cannot be awarded as described in these rules, the Company reserves the right to substitute a prize or prize component with another of comparable value, as determined in its sole discretion.

6.4. Refusal to accept the prize releases the Contest Parties from any obligation toward the winner.

6.5. If an entrant makes any false statement, (s)he will be automatically disqualified from the Contest.

The Contest Parties assume no liability for any loss, damage or injury, including without limitation: (i) lost, stolen, delayed, damaged, misdirected, late, destroyed, illegible or incomplete entries; (ii) loss, theft or damage to software or computer or telephone data, including any breach of privacy; (iii) fraudulent calls; (iv) inability of any person to participate in the Contest for any reason including mistaken addresses on mail or e-mail; technical, computer or telephone malfunctions or other problems with computer on-line systems, servers, access providers, computer equipment, or software; congestion on the internet or at any website, or any combination of the foregoing; (v) damage to any person's computer, including as a result of playing or downloading any material relating to the Contest; (vi) any delay or inability to act resulting from an event or situation beyond their control, including a strike, lockout or other labour dispute at their location or the locations of the organizations and

Should such an attempt be made, the Company reserves the right to seek remedies and damages to the fullest extent permitted by law, including criminal prosecution.

All personal information, such as name and contact information, is collected by the Company for the purposes of administering this Contest and shall be governed under the company's existing Privacy Policy. The individual assigned to the e-mail address for the domain associated with the submitted email address is considered the authorized account holder. A selected entrant may be required to provide proof that (s)he is the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with the selected entry. All entries must be submitted from a valid e-mail account that may be identified by reverse domain name search. The sole determinant of time for the purposes of receipt of a valid entry in this Contest will be the Contest server.

All entries that are incomplete, illegible, damaged, irregular, have been submitted through illicit means, using any robotic, automatic programmed method that artificially increases the odds of winning or do not conform to or satisfy any condition of the rules may be disqualified by the Company. 6.13. Canadian winners must correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question as a condition of receiving their prize.

6.14. Winners are solely responsible for any federal, state, provincial, or local taxes, fees or other charges arising from the receipt of use of a prize.
