- 1) On a fishing trip, Breanna caught 3 fish in the morning and 2 in the afternoon.
How many fish did Breanna catch?

- 2) Yesterday, Ethan traveled 5 miles after already traveling 4 miles.
How many miles did Ethan travel?

- 3) Jessie bought 4 new toys at the store, and already had 4 toys at home.
How many toys does Jessie have?

- 4) Anna ate 7 snacks, then went back and got 3 more.
How many snacks did Anna have?

- 5) Benjamin threw 6 snowballs, then decided to throw 2 more.
How many snowballs did Benjamin throw?

Answer Key

Single Digit Addition Word Problems

- 1) On a fishing trip, Breanna caught 3 fish in the morning and 2 in the afternoon.
How many fish did Breanna catch?

$3 + 2 = 5$ Breanna caught 5 fish

- 2) Yesterday, Ethan traveled 5 miles after already traveling 4 miles.
How many miles did Ethan travel?

$5 + 4 = 9$ Ethan traveled 9 miles

- 3) Jessie bought 4 new toys at the store, and already had 4 toys at home.
How many toys does Jessie have?

$4 + 4 = 8$ Jessie has 8 toys

- 4) Anna ate 7 snacks, then went back and got 3 more.
How many snacks did Anna have?

$7 + 3 = 10$ Anna had 10 snacks

- 5) Benjamin threw 6 snowballs, then decided to throw 2 more.
How many snowballs did Benjamin throw?

$6 + 2 = 8$ Benjamin threw 8 snowballs
